
PROJECT: Crown Castle Wireless Telecommunication Facility, 2080 Golden Eagle Trail
P13-0059, Conditional Use Permit (CUP13-006)

Purpose for Notice:

The City of San Marcos invites residents to attend a workshop on Thursday, July 23 at 6:30 pm at the San Marcos Civic Center to view an applicant's presentation of a proposal to rehabilitate an existing wireless telecommunication facility located at 2080 Golden Eagle Trail (i.e. "the T-Mobile faux tree cell tower"). Please note that a decision on the project will occur at a subsequent Public Hearing before the Planning Commission and not at the July 23 workshop. A separate Notice of Public Hearing will be mailed for the future Planning Commission Hearing.

Project Background:

The project proposes to rehabilitate an existing wireless telecommunication facility and permit its continued operation for a period of ten years. The restoration proposed by the project would replace the existing faux tree camouflaging materials (i.e. branches and leaves) with new ones at a greater density than is currently used on the facility. The restoration would also include the installation of additional natural landscaping materials in the vicinity of the wireless telecommunication facility for the purpose of enhancing the screening of the existing facility from nearby residences.
