The Tribe has reviewed the ND and all of its supporting documentation as it pertains specifically to the protection and preservation of Luiseño Native American tribal cultural resources that may be located within the parameters of the Project’s property boundaries. The Tribe is satisfied and concurs with the proposed Tribal Cultural Resource Mitigation Measures contained within the ND.

The San Luis Rey Band of Mission Indians appreciates this opportunity to provide the City of San Marcos with our comments on the National Community Renaissance Project. As always, we look forward to working with the City to guarantee that the requirements of the CEQA are rigorously applied to this Project and all projects. We thank you for your continuing assistance in protecting our invaluable Luiseño tribal cultural resources.
