2. COMMISSIONERS CORNER- INTRODUCTION

Chair Andrews told Commissioners that this is something new and Commissioners can bring up issues or topics they would like to address. Commissioners discussed different topics they would like to address and some they have addressed before and would like to revisit.

Chair Andrews noted that afterschool kids will go to Hollandia Park and smoke cigarettes and marijuana and feels the Park Rangers program will help this issue.

Commissioner Vongsachang will update the Commission on a group he is involved in called National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) and next week is mental illness awareness week and they are working on a TEDX Talk.

Commissioner Flatley would like to start TED Talks for teens and try to make this happen at one of the high schools.

Staff Advisor Salazar noted City of Encinitas holds a leadership event that is a TEDX style half day conference that the Youth Commissioners sponsored and teens in Encinitas attend. Youth Commissioners are invited to attend on May 19th and they will be sending out an invitation soon. The Commission could consider doing an event like this in the future.

Commissioner Athalye noted drugs and alcohol are an issue on campus and there have been over 100 suspensions at San Marcos High. It would be great to take some action in the community as this is a serious problem. Commissioners all agree this is an issue and it would be great to offer support to help youth get off drugs and making better choices. Staff Advisor Salazar asked if the schools have any peer counselors or clubs that are already addressing this issue that the commission could partner with. Chair Andrews noted her school has PLUS. Commissioner Vongsachang will reach out to the NAMI president and see if she has any connections.

3. SOCIAL MEDIA REQUESTS

Staff Advisor Salazar noted the Office of Communications has denied the request for the Youth Commission to have their own social media account. Salazar noted the Commission can still submit posts and will go on the City social media.
