### **2. COMMISSION GOALS & ACTION ITEMS UPDATE**

Commissioners will collaborate through Google docs and Commissioners Athalye & Morrison will head up the project.

Staff advisor Salazar said we could also collaborate with the Red Ribbon week coordinators at the schools.
