

5. Crossing Church Facility Use Request

6. SMYB & SM Rugby Annual Presentation.

Barry Zeit and John Cody with San Marcos Rugby team presented the leagues successes and growth including student participation over the last three years all High Schools in San Marcos.

San Marcos Youth Basketball program director, Laura Kahler shared current league statistics with the commission which included the number of volunteers and hours, the core program, the Shooting Stars program, and the competitive program.

7. Trails Advisory Committee (TAC)

Commissioner Crain recapped the TAC meeting held on May 3, 2017 which addressed the mounted patrol program, horse sense 101, Bike to Work Day, August 21, 2017 solar eclipse, and Trail closure notifications. Commissioner Crain also recognized Aaron Gonzales, park ranger in leading the mounted patrol program to fruition.

8. Youth Sports Council (YSP)

Commissioner Mockus highlighted the Youth Sports Council meeting discussions held on May 2, 2017 including the Futsol program, field closures during summer break, Double Peak trail access, and ongoing field projects.

9. Youth Ambassador Selection Committee Member

Holly Malan, Program Manager requested a volunteer from the commission to review the Youth Ambassador applications and be part of the interview panel on May 31, 2017. Commissioner Lindsay volunteered.

10. July 4th Fireworks Fundraiser Update

Fundraising letters will be sent out the next day or two and online donations have started. Goal for this year is \$25,000.

- The NFL Flag Experience was held at the Walnut Grove Park last weekend and was a success.
- A Friends of San Marcos Parks and Recreation social event will be held in the fall and a formal invitation will follow.
- Music Festival will be held on Saturday, June 10, 2017 at Walnut Grove Park.
- Rail Trail video was presented by Commissioner Lindsay.

SUBJECT: PARKS & TRAILS Annual Report

Rangers

Two (2) additional staff Rangers were hired in fall 2016 to assist with opening closing parks in the morning and evening (previously handled by a security company). The ranger staff now consists of one (1) full-time Recreation Supervisor/Park Ranger, and four (4) part-time Park Rangers.

Volunteer Rangers

The Volunteer Park Rangers has been a huge help. This program augments the park ranger staff. The program has 28 volunteers that are trained and outfitted with Park Ranger uniforms. They assist with making a presence in the city parks, JPNC operations, City special events, and monthly City hikes. Volunteer Rangers contributed 153 hours through the course of the year to support the monthly hikes. In 2016 the Volunteer Ranger program was recognized by CPRS District 12 and received an award for outstanding recreation programming achievement.

Park Caretakers

The Park Caretakers also help the ranger staff keep order in the parks. The caretakers are the eyes and ears for the ranger staff. They keep staff informed of activities in the parks and trails. In 2016 park caretakers were trained in Public Relations and Rattlesnake safety. The Parks that currently have caretakers include:

- Double Peak Park
- Jacks Pond Park
- Hollandia Park
- Las Posas Park
- Mission sports Park
- Sunset Park
- Walnut Grove Park

The Trails Advisory Committee

The Trails Advisory Committee is a group is made up of 6 committee members.

These passionate residents of the City come with experience with equestrian, hiking & mountain biking. They assist with the development of the trail network. These folks have been a big help with:

- Trail map update
- Trail Master Plan update
- City Special events
- Monthly City hikes



Jacks Pond Nature Center

Thirteen public and private schools visited the nature center. Three schools were from San Marcos; Ten schools were from other cities: Escondido (4), Vista (2), Carlsbad (1), Bonsall (1), Valley Center (1), and Oceanside (1). There were a total of 24 field trip visits by schools. Two private groups reserved the Nature Center including the City of San Marcos Adventure Day Camp (5 visits) and Boy Scouts.

The total number of visitors to Jack's Pond Nature Center in 2016 was 3,263; 452 more than 2015. There were 26 rental group visits with a total attendance of 1,235. There were 1,838 visitors during the Saturday and Sunday open hours; the average number of visitors on weekend open hours was 18. Special events such as Bird Day, Reptile Day, Junior Ranger Day, and Halloween were hosted at Jack's Pond to educate visitors and bring awareness to the Nature Center. The events attracted a combined total of 178 visitors.

The Nature Center will remain open on Saturdays and Sundays from 10am-1pm in 2017 and continue to minimize the number of days closed to the public when advertised as open. The Center was open for 102 of 105 weekend days of 2016, closing only for Easter, Christmas Day, and New Years Eve holidays. This is a great improvement from the 90 open days in 2015 and helped bring an additional 310 weekend visitors in 2016.

Volunteer docents at Jack's Pond Nature Center contributed 183 hours on weekend days and during school visits. This was the first full year the Nature Center expanded operations to open to the public on Sundays in addition to Saturdays. The caretaker at Jack's Pond Nature Center provides assistance when school groups visit the Nature Center and contribute two days a month to open on the weekends. Volunteer Rangers Ann Gray, Bill Bixby, Terry Wolfe, Bruce Truax, and Andrea Buechler volunteered at the Nature Center on weekends, special events, and a few school field trips. At the end of 2016 the Nature Center lost long-time loyal volunteer, Ann Gray, when she moved to Alabama.

Programs and Events

There were 19 hikes and interpretive events with a total attendance of 1378 averaging 72 attendees per event. Volunteer rangers assisted with hike leadership and with participant sign-ins. Summer interpretive programs were held at Jack's Pond Nature Center. Project Wildlife educated visitors on birds and local wildlife in June and EcoVivarium presented a program in July featuring reptiles. Vallecitos Water District, San Diego County Parks and Recreation, and Project Wildlife attended the Junior Ranger Day hosted by Jack's Pond Nature Center in August. The Nature Center also opened late-night on Halloween for a family-friendly event of games and crafts for 105 visitors.

The twenty-fifth annual San Marcos Trails Day was held on Saturday, March 5th, 2017 at Discovery Lake and attracted 155 people. Equestrian riders were offered four-mile and six-mile routes while hikers were offered three guided routes between three-miles and seven-miles. Cal State San Marcos provided free Jersey Mike's sandwiches, Winco offered waters and bananas, and Jack's Pond Nature Center provided information and activities to participants and their families.

Three Eagle Scout projects were completed in 2016 to help improve Jack's Pond Nature Center and Park. As planned, the aquatic-themed room was completed in May 2016 by Klaus Neyer and has proven to be very popular among visitors. Two taxidermy boxes which are now on display in the Nature Center were built by Vishaan Singh. Lastly, a butterfly garden and interpretive sign were installed in the park by Justin Gaeta. The work done by these local Eagle Scouts will have sustainable and lasting impacts for the community and we will continue to maintain this great relationship.

Marketing & Outreach

The Discover San Marcos Hikes and activities at Jack's Pond Nature Center continue to be promoted through the City's website, the City's 360 magazine, and now increasingly on the City's social media pages. A hike calendar is mailed or emailed to Friends of San Marcos Parks and Trails members and other hike participants. The Nature Center and hikes have benefitted from the social media and marketing efforts such as #DiscoverSanMarcos campaign.

Outreach events such as the City Street Fairs on April 10th and October 9th along with the Horse Heritage Festival on October 16th provided great opportunities to dispense information about the park and trail system and the outdoor education program at Jack's Pond Nature Center. They also allowed us to expose the public to some of the fun and exciting items they could find by visiting the Nature Center.

Nature Center Director Kylee Wideman and Park Ranger Hugh McMenamin provided two educational presentations to Preschoolers at Richland Elementary that are unable to leave campus to visit the Center. The Nature Center also made a visit to Mountain Shadow Outreach in San Marcos, giving two presentations to their child care group and developmentally-disabled adult group.

James Daza called the Youth Sports Council meeting to order at 6:05pm.

Approval of Minutes

San Marcos Parks Update

Art Sotelo updated the YSC about ongoing projects and field conditions. Art reminded all YSC members that most multipurpose fields are currently closed for rest and renovation.

The City of San Marcos Parks division of Public Works was replacing sod at Walnut Grove North, Las Posas Park, Hollandia Park, Sunset Park and San Elijo Park Hilltop during the closure. San Elijo Lower softball field is scheduled to be closed beginning on July 5 to allow the outfield to have new sod installed.

The plexiglass replacement project is scheduled to begin on June 19 at Sunset Park and should be completed in two to three days.

James reminded the YSC members that with the upcoming SMUSD field closures and City field closures in San Elijo that it is important to return any unused field space. Returning unused field space will help San Elijo AYSO and other groups to find enough space for their teams to practice.

He told Art and James that there were some challenges with the Tegriscape company not have staff stay at the park during their entire requested times. Art told the YSC members that if they are

paying for extra service, Tegrandscape is supposed to have a staff member at that facility at all times during their event.

James informed the YSC that no groups wanted to work concession stands during the Triple Crown Sports tournament so they will handle that themselves. James asked Art if the field preparation would be able to be completed by 7:45am because Triple Crown has games beginning at 8am.
