**2. ARTS AND CULTURAL GRANT PROGRAM PROPOSALS**

**(A) BOYS & GIRLS CLUB OF SAN MARCOS**

The committee discussed the request for funding from Boys & Girls Club of San Marcos to continue its implementation and expansion of a youth fine arts program.

**(B) ART ANIMATES LIFE**

The committee discussed the request for funding from Art Animates Life to facilitate two live stage productions.

**(C) CAL STATE SAN MARCOS FOUNDATION**

The committee discussed the request for funding from Cal State San Marcos Foundation to support its Art and Lectures Signature Event. Board member Monahan stated that she spoke with the Foundation about the project expenses and was told the amounts are for several art and lecture signature events they plan to have. The Foundation is asking for grant funding for one art and lecture signature event.

#### **(A) FRATERNITY HOUSE**

The committee discussed the request from Fraternity House to replace broken and inefficient appliances that are used at its facility caring for very low income or homeless individuals disabled by HIV/AIDS. Board member Confrey reported on his site visit to Fraternity House.

#### **(B) PALOMAR COLLEGE FOUNDATION**

The committee discussed the request for funding from Palomar College Foundation to provide a suite of programs through its "Bridge to Success" program for underserved students.

#### **(C) BOYS & GIRLS CLUB OF SAN MARCOS**

The committee discussed the request from the Boys & Girls Club to fund field trips, community service supplies and activities through its Civic Engagement Project.

#### **(D) PARTNERSHIPS WITH INDUSTRY**

The committee discussed the request for funding to provide San Marcos residents with intellectual or developmental disabilities with workforce training, support, and placement. It was noted the program would serve only 11 San Marcos residents

#### **(E) MIRACLE BABIES**

The committee discussed the request for funding to provide services through its Family Assistance Program, which assists families with an infant in the NICU.

**BOARD MEMBER MONAHAN MOTIONED TO RECOMMEND THE FOLLOWING GRANT AMOUNTS TO THE FULL FOUNDATION BOARD FOR CONSIDERATION AT ITS NEXT MEETING: \$5,281.97 TO FRATERNITY HOUSE, \$1,150 TO PALOMAR COLLEGE FOUNDATION AND \$5,000 (CHALLENGE GRANT) TO BOYS & GIRLS CLUB OF SAN MARCOS. BOARD MEMBER CONFREY SECONDED. MOTION PASSED BY UNANIMOUS VOICE VOTE.**


**8. MISCELLANEOUS**
