Mr. Butler Staff Advisor for the Plus Club at Mission Hills High School spoke to the Commission about the positive things the club does for the students at school. Mr. Butler would like to see the Plus Club and the Commission collaborate. Mr. Butler has been a teacher for ten years and he loves to teach and high school age group is his favorite age.

Plus is a national organization that has developed a mission to keep school youth safe and a network for youth in crisis to speak to peers who can mentor them.

Plus is about seeing and understanding on a deeper level to get to the heart of the problem for many students on campus dealing with certain issues. Plus has made a pledge to not ignore these students facing hard times.

Plus also conducts surveys to get more information from the student population about what they are facing at school. Plus will have a student forum in September usually held on campus so Mr. Butler told students to watch for the date.

2. YOUTH COMMISSIONER SUMMIT

Chair Andrews felt the summit was a great experience. Chair Andrews feels like we have a plan for moving forward. Commissioner Athalye really enjoyed interacting with the people in government that attended. Commissioner Williams felt the summit was helpful because each speaker brought a new feature on what the Commission is trying to accomplish. Commissioner Flatley noted it will help the Commission see what issues it needs to focus on. Commissioner Jorge said it was very eye opening to learn about the different services in the community such as the LGBTQ center. Commissioner Kaushik said it was a great experience and very eye opening.

3. KEY ISSUE DISCUSSION

Staff Advisor Salazar asked Commissioners to talk about which key issues the Commissioner want to focus on.

Chair Andrews noted with the drug awareness issue we can easily partner with the Plus Club and Yellow Ribbon Week. Commissioner Athalye noted if we discuss mental health first it could support many of the other issues. Commissioner Flatley said the mental health would also bring awareness for suicide prevention.

Commissioners will narrow down their top choices and compile it in the google doc and a decision will be made at the next meeting.

4. COMMISSIONER'S CORNER

Chair Andrews said at the summit it was briefly discussed possibly holding a teen music event or competition like battle of the bands. The community does not have a lot of events for teens so it would be nice to hold an event like this. The event could also include a talent, writing and composing aspect to it. Commissioners will form a subcommittee and work out the logistics at the next meeting.

Commissioner Athalye had the idea to have a program much like the Kids Connect to Culture event at the library but would speak about the five main religions in our world. Commissioners Athalye, Flatley, Andrews will be on the subcommittee and Commissioners Kaushik and Vijaykumar can also help with the event.

Commissioner Jorge said it would be great to have an event about environmental protection. The Commission may be able to inform the youth of San Marcos as well as adults on how to solve environmental issues such as global warming. The event could include a fair with booths or stations to get information on different environmental issues.
