### **REPORTS AND OTHER BUSINESS**

#### **4. South Lake Presentation, Associate Civil Engineer Isaac Etchamendy -**

Associate Civil Engineer Isaac Etchamendy reported on the South Lake Park project.

Items presented included current timeline of the project, a recent photo of South Lake, and changes that have been made to the project plan. Isaac reported that all planning approvals are now complete and all regulatory permits have been submitted. A biological assessment and 50% of the construction plans have been completed. He anticipates all construction plans and regulatory permits to be complete by winter 2017/18. The project is currently scheduled to start construction in spring 2018.

The Commissioners recommended city staff to investigate a way to include a restroom in the current South Lake project.

Commissioner Maas requested a map with the acceleration lane included.

#### **5. Annual Staff Presentation, Program Manager Holly Malan -**

Program manager Holly Malan gave an update on the San Marcos Community Garden and the San Marcos Rotating Art Gallery.

She spoke about the history of the garden, the different groups who use the garden for educational purposes, the number of plots being used, and the number of people on the wait list.

Holly then presented information regarding the public art display also known as the Rotating Art Gallery at the Community Center. Her report included the gallery schedule, the annual Juried Art & Photography Show statistics, the Palomar College Juried Photography Show schedule, and the application and display process of local artists' work.

Holly invited commissioners to volunteer for the San Marcos Street Fair booth. There are two, two hour shifts still open for Sunday, October 8, 2017.

#### **6. Trails Advisory Committee Meeting September 6, 2017 -**

Commissioner Maas reported discussions at the trails advisory committee meeting held on September 6, 2017. Discussions included the master trail plan workshop results, the mounted and bike patrol updates, and the solar eclipse spectators at Double Peak Park on August 21, 2017.

#### **7. Youth Sports Council Meeting September 5, 2017-**

Chairperson Jay Franklin reported discussions at the Youth Sport Council meeting about teenagers and young adults bringing illegal paraphernalia into Hollandia Park during Mission Hills High School football games. It was requested that a ranger or sheriff be present at Hollandia Park during football games. Chairperson Franklin asked city staff if the concerns have been addressed. Director Buck Martin stated that the Community Services department has been in close communication with the school principal and the sheriff's department and the issue has been addressed.

Also discussed, an issue with Friday Night Lights and NFL Flag Football teams encroaching on YSC members' allocated practice times and the city receiving complaints from YSC groups.

Chairperson Franklin asked city staff if this issue had been addressed. Director Buck Martin stated he and supervisor James Daza are working very closely with all groups involved to resolve this issue.

Chairperson Franklin also reported that developer Brookfield Residential has committed to donate \$20,000 to the Friends of San Marcos to be utilized for youth sports needs in San Marcos.

Director Buck Martin stated the youth orchestra, a group of children teaching children, has been using the facility for 10 years and has always had an adult supervise them during their meetings. Recently there have been changes with the youth orchestra and they no longer have an adult willing to supervise them. Due to risk and liability reasons the city requires the orchestra group to have a responsible adult sign a liability waiver and be present at each meeting.

Commissioner Smith asked if the homeless population around the library has been an issue. Director Martin said there are security guards patrolling the Civic Center property and there have not been additional issues reported.






