Evaluation Process

Public Works (PW) has developed a set of criteria to evaluate playgrounds based on a variety of factors:

- Age, structural and visual condition, user age group
- All playgrounds inspected weekly by PW staff
 - Consistent visual and physical checklist
 - Tracked in our work order database
- All playgrounds inspected monthly by a state Certified Playground Safety Inspector (CPSI)

Rating Scale

All playgrounds are monitored closely through monthly inspections, and are rated using the following system:

- **Green** - Indicates that play equipment is in fairly good condition and may not need to be replaced anytime soon.
- **Yellow** - Indicates that play equipment is in fair condition and will need to be replaced as soon as financially feasible.
- **Orange** - Indicates that play equipment is in poor condition and will need replacement soon.
- **Red** - Indicates that play equipment is in very poor condition and will need replacement soon.

Replacement Process

Once ratings have been evaluated, PW implements replacement plan on annual basis:

- City has been striving to standardize equipment and surfacing as playgrounds are replaced
- Annual funding is re-requested each FY (~\$240K/yr) and is not guaranteed but has historically been funded
- Aim to replace (3) playgrounds per year on average



Call to order

James Daza called the Youth Sports Council meeting to order at 6:00pm.

Approval of Minutes

Kelly Breihan (SMYL) motioned to approve the minutes from the December 5, 2017 meeting. Chris Williams (NFL Flag Football) seconded the motion.

Motion carried 4-0 with San Marcos Youth Baseball and SM United abstaining.

Fairfield Inn by Marriott

Ashley Manley; the Director of Sales at the Farfield Inn by Marriott, presented to the YSC members and gave information on their hotel located off of San Marcos Boulevard and Twin Oaks Valley Road. She gave the YSC members information about possible partnerships when they are hosting tournaments in San Marcos and the amenities they can offer to teams needing a place to stay.

San Marcos Unified School District Update

Martin Leon updated the YSC about SMUSD field renovations and current projects. San Marcos Middle School has six out of twelve light poles working; the working poles are on the two baseball fields. Woodland Park Middle School is in the final stages of having their solar panels installed, the projected opening of the field was pushed back because of damage to the grass, and the opening should be at the end of April. The solar panel installation will start soon at San Marcos Middle, San Marcos Elementary and San Elijo Middle Schools. The solar project at San Marcos Middle School will take place on the south side of the sports fields and should not affect the field use. Martin informed the YSC that the following school fields will be



closed from June 15 through August 15, 2018; San Elijo Elementary, San Elijo Middle School, Woodland Park Middle School (field inside of the track) and Paloma Elementary.

James reminded all YSC members to submit all school district permits directly to LaTanya prior to using any fields.

San Marcos Parks Update

Art Sotelo updated the YSC about upcoming projects to various parks.

Public Works is in the process of obtaining all necessary permits to begin construction on the shade structures over the Bradley Park Soccer Arena spectator seating. Art hopes to have the project completed by June 30, 2018. Mike Dutton (SMYS) asked if there would be any issue with parents using the stands at the soccer arena during the shade structure installation, Art did not believe there will be any issue with access to the stands.

Art informed the YSC that the multipurpose fields have held up well during the winter due to the warm weather we have had. Art reminded the YSC members about the memorandum Public Works has been working on to add to special event permits that request the use of sports fields. He hopes to have that finalized soon and can provide a copy to the YSC when it is finalized.

Art mentioned that Public Works has purchased a second reel lawn mower. This type of lawn mower allows the grass to be kept in better playing shape and is necessary for the sports field turf care.

James asked SMYB and SMGS what dates would be best to close down Bradley Park and Mission Sports Park during the summer for renovations. Molly Carpenter (SMYB) said anytime between July 7 and August 11 is best for Mission Sports Park. Jeremy Vargas (SMGS) said anytime after their All-Stars are finished would be best for Bradley Park; he will be able to provide dates closer to the end of their season.

Club Soccer Field Request

James reminded all club soccer organizations to have their coaches submit all field requests for additional field space through their field coordinators. James explained that the Gymnasium staff has received a larger number of coaches requesting additional field space before contacting their organizations field coordinator.



Connors and Hollandia Park

James reminded all YSC members that the field allocation at Connors Park will change from the previous months of the allocation due to other fields opening. He reminded all YSC members to review their portion of the allocation for clarification.

James updated the YSC on the situation at Hollandia Park. There have been fewer reports of vandalism and teenagers present after dark since the City decided to turn off the lights at the skate park.

AYSO 1505 Rebranding

James informed the YSC that AYSO Matrix is going through a rebranding. They will now be called North County Football Club (NCFC). Wayne Marking and Patrick Jenkinson were not present at the meeting but James informed the YSC that they are still focusing on the San Elijo Community and are rebranding to possibly help keep the older club soccer participants in their club.

NCFC Tournament Request

James informed the YSC that NCFC is in the process of getting a stay and play two day tournament approved at Walnut Grove Park for August 4-5, 2018.

YSC Club Soccer Tryouts

James informed the club soccer directors to look at their tryout dates and prevent have three days per week booked for tryouts in 2019.

Mike Dutton provided feedback about the field space usage during the winter field closure period, mentioning that SMYS and NCFC have 28 club teams each and compared to 23 teams last year they have needed more field space.
