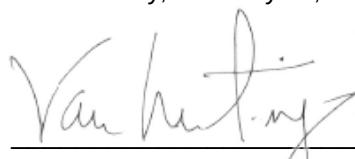

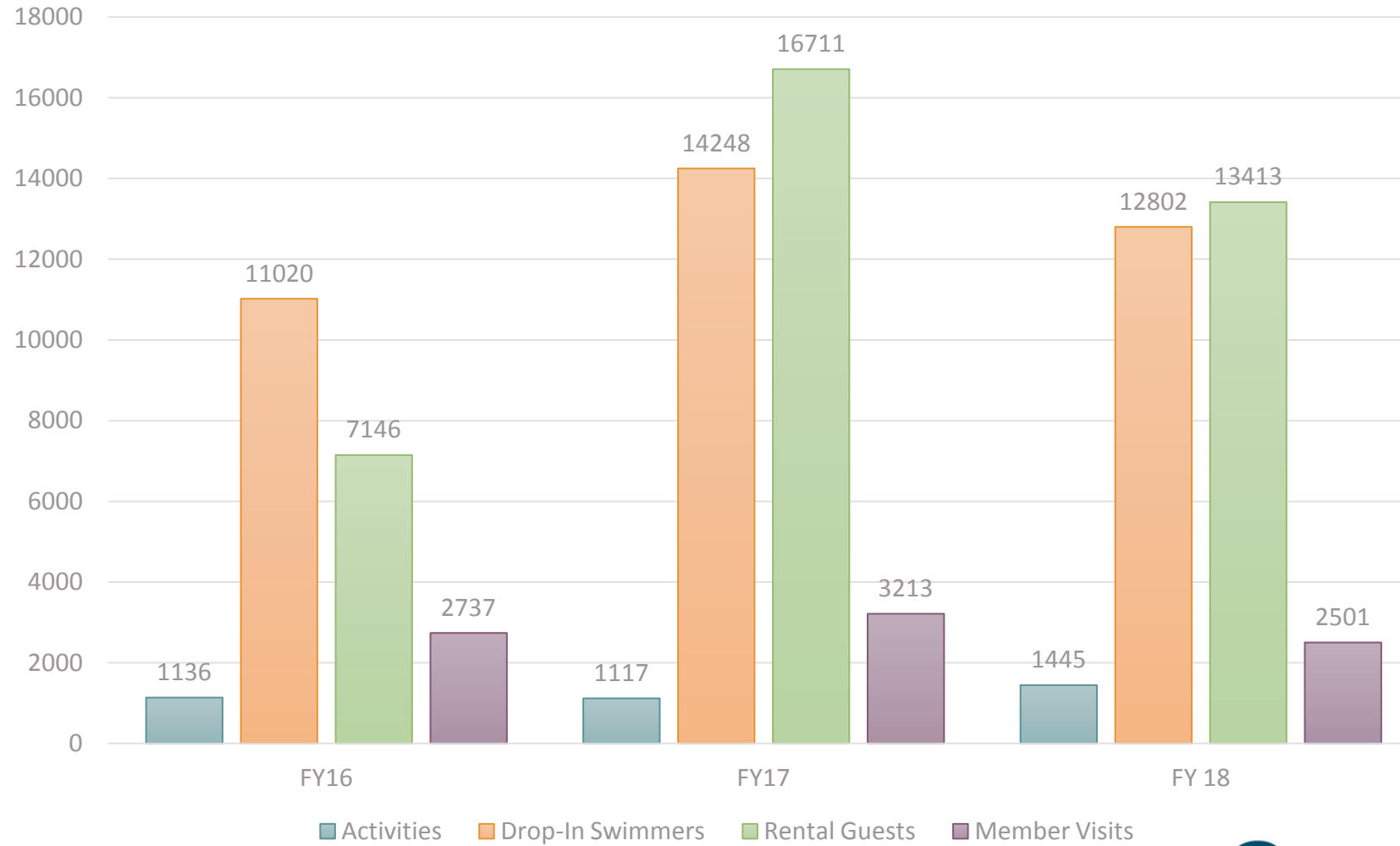

Call to order

James Daza called the Youth Sports Council meeting to order at 6:05pm.

Approval of Minutes

Doug Scharin (San Elijo AYSO 1505) motioned to approve the minutes from the December 4, 2018 meeting. Tina Sybesma (San Marcos Girls Softball) seconded the motion.

Motion carried 9-0.

San Diego Sockers

Savanna Moorehouse spoke to the YSC and provided information about group rates and fundraising opportunities for their organizations. She provided her business cards and a flyer with more information.

San Marcos Unified School District Update

San Marcos Unified School District fields update was given by Joe Navarra.

Joe notified the Youth Sports Council members that all field lining has to be done after school hours and to let him know when they will have their lines painted so he can notify the school. He reminded the Youth Sports Council to use water based turf paint and to avoid using white.

James reminded all members that although they are allocated San Marcos Unified fields, they must complete the permit process with La Tanya Tatum-Milner before they are approved for use at the school sites. He reminded all members that there is no restroom access at school



sites unless specifically requested through La Tanya and will be charged \$39.50 per hour for staffing fees, otherwise the groups must provide portable toilets for their participants.

James stated that he will be programming all lights for San Marcos Middle School. La Tanya will send the approved permits to James and based on their hours they are approved for he will program the lights.

Joe stated that the baseball fields are still under construction at San Marcos Middle School and there is no confirmed end date for construction.

Sport Field Updates

Sports fields update was given by Art Sotelo.

Art reported that Public Works was able to aerate and over seed the Upper softball field at San Elijo and Bradley Park Multipurpose #1 during the field closure with help from West Coast Turf. They were also able to repair netting, bullpens and backstops at Mission Sports Park during the December 17 through January 11 closure period.

James and Art updated the Youth Sports Council about the Bradley Park Upper electrical issue. The electrical contractor was able to identify the problem with the wiring and should have the lights operational in about a week.

Art informed all Youth Sports Council members that before any repairs or improvements are started at any City facilities all groups must submit a scope of work and all proper insurance documents prior to approval from the City.

Art notified all members that the City and San Marcos Unified School District are working together to have a field turf seminar in late June or July, he will keep all members updated.

Michelle Morgan (AYSO 127) informed all members that there are signs missing stating that there are no dogs allowed on sports fields.

Art informed the Youth Sports Council that the parking plan for Walnut Grove Park has been approved. There will be more no parking signage and red curb for critical areas on the north end of the park to allow for adequate emergency services access.

Spring/Summer Field Allocation



James notified all members that all soccer groups will have to work together to come up with a field space solution once all organizations have completed their club soccer tryouts to accommodate any shift in participations numbers.

James reminded all YSC members that on March 1, the Connors Park allocation will change since all multipurpose fields will be open.

Joanne Shannon (AYSO 127) notified James that their arena soccer games will be ending by 5:30pm at the Bradley Arena. Sean Houshmandi (San Marcos Youth Soccer) stated that they have been able to get all of their arena soccer games in at Sunset Park in the time allotted.

Lori Schultz (SM United) stated that the North County Rugby practices at Connors Park are for their adult program, not youth. Lori asked James if Rugby would be able to push their practice time back one hour and begin at 8pm to allow for soccer groups an extra hour of practice time. James will check with Barry Zeait (Rugby) to see if this is possible. Lori also asked for another practice night at San Marcos Middle School for their teams.

Tina Sybesma (San Marcos Girls Softball) notified James that there will be limited availability for High Tech High North County for their softball season. She stated Tuesday's are not available, but Wednesday or Thursday might be an option.

James reminded San Marcos Pop Warner that their storage unit needs to be removed from Bradley Park. San Marcos Pop Warner had it scheduled but the towing company never submitted the proper insurance documents to remove the container.
