### Regular Meeting of the San Marcos Parks & Recreation Commission

#### **REPORTS AND OTHER BUSINESS**

##### **4. Annual Youth Sports Group Presentation, San Marcos Youth Baseball**

A representative from San Marcos Youth Baseball was not present. They will be rescheduled.

##### **5. Parks and Trails Report, Recreation Coordinator Taylor Oshinski**

Recreation Coordinator Taylor Oshinski reported on the ranger program along with his key team members to speak on their area of expertise.

Hugh McMenamin, Lead Ranger for almost five years oversees the volunteer ranger, training of new staff and enforcement and patrolling at the parks and trails.

Erin Rimmereid, Park and Trail Ranger has been with the City a little over a year and assists with running the interpretive programs at the Nature Center.

Courtney Pache, Ranger for over a year does enforcement of the parks and trails and is putting together a mounted patrol unit for the City.

Taylor reported that the Ranger program and operation was moved from the Community Center offices to the Gymnasium office. Seven part time rangers are scheduled up to 1,000 hours per year and generally work 20 hour per week mostly in the evenings and weekends when the parks are the busiest. Taylor also gave an update on the caretaker program noting the caretaker's roles expanded and they now open and close more park locations and work 7-18 hours per week.

Hugh reported that the volunteer ranger program has 21 active volunteers that all receive basic training in dealing with the public and how to enforce the ordinances within the parks and trails. The volunteers provide around 200 volunteer hours per month. John Walsh a volunteer ranger was the grand champion of the 2019 Parks and Recreation Grand Champion award for his Starwalk events held at Double Peak Park.

Erin noted that the Nature Center is open Saturdays and Sundays from 10am-1pm and is staffed by volunteers who are dedicated to the Nature Center. Each Thursday during the school year schools have field trips to the center. In the future they are looking at offering a birthday party package at the center.

Courtney noted the City has a huge equestrian community and her goal is to provide a mounted patrol in San Marcos. She observes and reports trail use and conditions while riding the horse along with educating the public on horse etiquette.

#### **6. Trails Advisory Committee Meeting- July 10, 2019**

Program Manager Darren Chamow noted this was the first meeting since the transition and it went well. Moving forward the committee will meet quarterly. Darren reviewed items discussed at the meeting including the trails master plan updated, mountain bike track and trail map updates.

#### **7. Trails Advisory Committee Meeting Sign Up for September 11, 2019**

Chair Franklin will attend the September 11<sup>th</sup> meeting and the next 4-5 meetings for consistency.

#### **8. Special Events List and Social Media Posts**

Commissioner Hernandez went to the farmers market last week and they had several food vendors, lots of produce and pastries.

### **9. 4<sup>th</sup> of July Update**

Program Manager Andrea Gonzalez gave the final update on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July fundraising. The final raised is \$25,104 and there were 35 new donors this year. The day of the event \$835 was collected at the park. For next year Andrea is looking at using Venmo for donations on site and also plan some restaurant fundraisers.

### **ORAL COMMUNICATIONS**

Parks & Recreation Program Manager Andrea Gonzalez gave an update on the following items:

- City purchased software to assist the City in gathering analytics of online chatter on social media and the City website to create a dashboard of information for City staff to utilize.
- The City will feature a news release on volunteer John Walsh winning the Recreation Champion Award. This is the first time our City has won.
- Through the Jack's Pond Nature Center grant from the Friends of San Marcos 237 children were able to visit the nature center. The grant will continue again this school year for the Title 1 schools and hope to expand by offering transportation to the nature center.

### **COMMISSIONER COMMENTARY**

Commissioner Sensmeier thanked Darren and Andrea for their hard work on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July event.

Chair Franklin noted he is excited the City has a new Communications Director. Franklin asked to be notified in advance for community meetings as he was notified by the City on social media at the last minute. Program Manager Andrea Gonzalez will email the Commissioners the schedule for the community meetings.

### **WRITTEN COMMUNICATION**

A resident emailed the Commission about the skate park being closed in the evening which was handed out to the Commissioners. Program Manager Andrea Gonzalez said since we have closed the skate park at dusk over a year ago we have had only had a few inquires about the change. We have had less graffiti, vandalism and behavioral issues and this has overall improved the issues at the park.



TRAILS ADVISORY COMMITTEE  
GUIDELINES- February 20, 2008**

Section 1

Purpose

The purpose of the Trails Advisory Committee shall be to advise the Community Services Commission and through them the City Council, of the multi-use trail needs of the city and on the implementation of the City Master Trail Plan. Further, the Trails Advisory Committee shall encourage community involvement in development, maintenance and use of the trail system and bicycle facilities within the city.

Section 2

Duties

The duties of the Trails Advisory Committee shall include the following:

- A. Monitor the City's Master Trail Plan and Bicycle Facilities Master Facilities Plan ("trails") and submit recommendations for trails-related matters to the Community Services Commission.
- B. Identify existing and future needs for trail development within the city, including interconnections with regional trails outside the city's boundaries.
- C. Review existing programs and standards, recommending changes as deemed necessary.
- D. Review the status of existing trails and recommend future improvements and additions to the trails system.
- E. Recommend priorities for trails development for budget consideration and grant applications.
- F. Seek out and identify potential new sources of funding for trail development, improvement and maintenance.
- G. Encourage and advise on citizen involvement in the use, development and maintenance of trails, including Volunteer Park Rangers and docents, Eagle Scouts, school groups, interns, etc..
- H. Discuss and receive input from members of the public about trails-related matters.
- I. Educate the public about the existence and scope of the city's Master Trail Plan, Bicycle Facilities Master Plan and related matters.
- J. Encourage interpretive and educational information along trails, through the use of kiosks, trail signage and interpretive centers.

Section 3Appointment

- A. The Trails Advisory Committee shall consist of one member of the Community Services Commission appointed by that commission, who shall serve as a tie-breaking member on the committee, and six community members (including one alternate) appointed by the Community Services Commission.
- B. Committee members shall be residents of the city, except that one member may be a property owner in the city sphere area, and shall represent diverse trail user groups of the community.
- C. Members shall serve at the will of the Community Services Commission.
- D. The Community Services Director and/or his/her designee shall be an ex-officio member of the committee and serve in an advisory capacity.

Section 4Terms of office

Members of the Trails Advisory Committee appointed by the Community Services Commission shall serve a three-year term (with two members expiring each year).

Section 5Voting

Each committee member shall be entitled to one vote. Approval of any recommendation requires an affirmative vote from the majority of the members present, provided a quorum of three members is present and voting.

Section 6Termination of Membership

If a member misses more than two (2) consecutive meetings of the Committee, without prior authorization from the Chair, such member shall be considered to have resigned from the Committee.

Section 7Meetings

- A. Regular meetings of the committee shall be scheduled quarterly, or more often as needed, at a time and place agreed to by the Committee.
- B. Special meetings and sub-committee meetings may be called at any time by the Chair, provided that notification is given to all interested parties.

Section 8 Financial Disclosure

It is the determination of the City Attorney that this Committee is not subject to the Financial Disclosure and meeting requirements of the Ralph M. Brown Act.

Section 9 Officers

A. The officers of the Committee shall be a Chair and Vice-Chair selected by the membership of the Committee. Other officers may be appointed as necessary to carry out the work of the Committee.

B. The Chair and Vice-Chair shall be chosen annually by the Committee at the March meeting.

Section 10 Duties of Officers

A. Duties of the Chairperson

The Chair shall preside at all meetings of the Committee and shall act as the Committee's liaison to the Community Services Commission and as spokesperson at other events or meetings as requested by the Community Services Commission.

B. Duties of the Vice-Chairperson

In the absence or incapacity of the Chair, the Vice-Chair shall assume all duties of the Chair.

Section 11 Ad-Hoc Committees

The Committee may create such ad-hoc sub-committees as the business of the Committee may require. Each shall be made up of at least one but fewer than a quorum of Committee members and shall have such authority and perform such duties as the Trails Advisory Committee may determine.

Section 12 Compensation

Members of the Trails Advisory Committee shall serve without compensation.

Section 13 Procedures

These procedures shall be reviewed and revised as deemed necessary upon approval by the Community Services Commission.

### **TAC Options**

#### **1. Trails Subcommittee**

Ask the commission to appoint (2) members to serve as the Trails Subcommittee. The (2) members would meet with staff regularly (frequency determined by commission) where they are informed of any trails-related issues and then they present those items in summary to the commission at the subsequent commission meeting. Commission to give direction to staff based on these summaries if follow up action is needed. TAC meetings are put on hold until further notice.

#### **2. Staff Presentation**

Taylor to present on a semi-regular basis to the commission and inform them of all trails related concerns that have been brought to his attention. Commission can determine frequency of presentations and are free to agendize anything necessary or give staff direction to follow up on items. TAC meetings are put on hold until further notice.

#### **3. Community Input on Agenda**

Agendize items as they are brought to staff's attention from the trails community and allow commission to discuss them during regular meetings. TAC meetings are put on hold until further notice.

#### **4. Revise & Revamp TAC**

Continue with the TAC schedule as recently updated (quarterly meetings), but with the plan of revamping the TAC guidelines established in 2008. Commissioners shall provide input on what they want from the TAC as well as helping to find committed participants for the committee. Current participants will be asked to affirm their commitment and ensure they understand attendance requirements.



## Parks and Recreation Discourse Breakdown



This past month, the topic of Parks and Recreation generated 10% of the total discourse in the city.

The central issues making up the conversation on parks and recreation were:

- Posts promoting the city's parks using #parksmakelifebetter - 43%
- Promotions for the Double Peak Challenge - 28%
- Dog park at San Elijo Hills Park closing for renovations - 14%
- Community meeting about upgrades to Bradley Park - 8%
- Arboretum upgrades - 7%

It is worth mentioning that #parksmakeslifebetter and the Double Peak Challenge, both of which were the most central in the discourse, were the ones with the most posts by the city's official sources.


This means that the city is a key driver of conversation on this issue; the potential to increase visibility and engagement on park-related issues rests primarily with the city.

Residents are encouraged to enjoy the city's public parks and the many miles of trails while being mindful and observing all park rules. By being considerate of others and following all park and trail rules, our residents and visitors can safely enjoy what this community has to offer. 


