Regular Meeting of the Parks and Recreation Commission

CALL TO ORDER

At 6:00p.m. Parks and Recreation Commission Chair Franklin called the meeting to order.

MOVED BY COMMISSIONER MOCKUS-VALENZUELA, SECOND BY COMMISSIONER PRESTININZI AND CARRIED TO APPROVE CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS #1 APPROVAL OF MINUTES AS PRESENTED. COMMISSIONERS DIAZ, LINDSAY, SMITH ABSTAINED.

2. Approval of General Facility Scheduling, 07/21 - 8/17/2022

MOVED BY COMMISSIONER SMITH, SECOND BY COMMISSIONER MOCKUS-VALENZUELA AND CARRIED TO APPROVE CONSENT CALENDAR ITEM #2 GENERAL FACILITY SCHEDULING AS PRESENTED.

REPORTS AND OTHER BUSINESS

3. Annual Report

Daniel Max, San Marcos Youth Baseball, gave the presentation.

Daniel noted SMYB is rapidly growing and some divisions are outgrowing the facility they have. This spring they had 779 enrollments for the recreation league which is about 63 teams. They also support another 7 teams who participate in local tournaments and they also have two travel teams. The 6U and 8U teams qualified for the World Series this year and placed 8th. Since coming out of Covid being able to compete was very exciting.

SMYB held a Memorial Day tournament which was very successful and the snack bar opened back up and they were able to generate \$18,000 in revenue that the club can use to give back to the City and community. They also hold a Halloween tournament and they also do a fundraiser with Mitchell 4th organization.

SMYB is adding a fundraising and public relations director to the board to help the club continue to thrive.

Enrollment is great across the board but they are noticing the 10-14 age group is having the most growth and the 8 and under enrollment has declined some.

The organization is nonprofit but year after year they continue to bring in more than they spend. They are looking at larger projects to coordinate with the City such as synthetic turf upgrades and new score board components and overall maintenance of the fields to assist the City as much as possible.

Chair Franklin thanked Daniel for his report, and thanked his organization for the service they provide to the Community.

Commissioner Mockus-Valenzuela asked what ages does the organization service. Daniel noted they only go up to 14 years of age as the size of the fields don't accommodate 15 and up as they would need to be larger fields like a high school would have. They do have 45 youth umpires and they are looking to grow that opportunity.

Vice-Chair Lindsay asked if there is any constraints with the field availability. Daniel noted they don't have enough field space for the 11/12 division and they do have to push away about 30 players as they only have one field to play on. If they had one more field for that age group they would be completely fine. Vice-Chair Lindsay suggested recognizing his predecessor for her volunteer work over the past eight years here at a Commission meeting.

Chair Franklin said the organization is doing great work and the successes should be shared with the Youth Sports Council as it says a lot about how the organization is running things successfully.

Commissioner Smith asked if the organization has scholarships. Daniel noted they do offer scholarships for families in need and also offer payment plans if needed.

Director Martin is waiting on an update from the City Manager's Office. He will report back as things progress.

6. Trails Advisory Committee (TAC)

Director Martin noted there is two applicants for reappointment and two applicants who would be new appointments.

MOVED BY COMMISSIONER MOCKUS-VALENZUELA, SECOND BY COMMISSIONER SMITH AND CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY TO APPOINT OLGA FLORES AND RANDALL SMITH TO A SEAT ON THE TRAILS ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

MOVED BY COMMISSIONER SMITH, SECOND BY COMMISSIONER PRESTININZI AND CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY TO RE-APPOINT DAVID SIMPSON AND JOHN WALSH TO THE TRAILS ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

Chair Franklin asked if there is an opportunity to share with the new TAC members the homework that was requested at a previous meeting about the action items that needs to get worked on first.

Director Martin noted yes that will be discussed along with getting closure on the Trails Master Plan based on the recommendations from the TAC and City Engineering Department. Martin will be bringing more information from Engineering about the plan at an upcoming meeting.

PARKS AND RECREATION DIRECTOR REPORT

Director Buck Martin informed the Commission on department events and updates including department personnel changes and new hires that happened over the past month.

Assistant Director Andrea Gonzalez noted July is Parks and Recreation month and we accepted the proclamation from City Council at the first meeting in July and what our City is doing to celebrate is a City Passport program where participants visit City sites and other organizations in San Marcos to get a stamp. Once they collect all of their stamps, they can come to the Community Center and get a goody bag.

Chair Franklin said this is a very cool program and asked if we can collect data on how many passports were picked up.

4th of July was a great success and Martin thanked Andrea and her team for all their hard work making the event run smoothly. Fundraising went well, we almost hit the \$35,000 mark. Two Movies in the Park were held in June and July and were well attended.

Bradley Park bike pump track is open for bidding and the project only had two bidders. Engineering is working to award the bid at the September 13th City Council meeting.

Kimely-Horn has begun construction on the sports fields for Park A in the Rancho Tesoro community. The park has not yet been named.

Since Christina Federico spoke at the last meeting about the expansion of the dog park at San Elijo Park city staff have been to the site to determine what options we have and what the potential costs would be. It would likely cost about \$65,000 to expand the dog park. The City doesn't have the funding for this so Director Martin has suggested she reach out to San Elijo Hills HOA as they have funds and may be looking to do improvements to the area.

The Boys and Girls Club is holding a fundraiser Flapjacks for Backpacks that will be held on August 6th at San Marcos Elementary School.

City staff visited Fulton House site to see what possibilities could happen at this site. Expansion of community garden and also looking at the possibly of pickle ball courts if we can secure grant funds.

The first concert of the season will happen this Saturday at 7:30pm, the Family campout will be held Saturday, July 30th.

Chair Franklin asked if the Commissioners will have the opportunity to name the park and input for the park amenities. Director Martin noted public meetings will be held and the Commission will be involved before it goes to the City Council for approval.

WRITTEN COMMUNICATIONS

Commissioners Robles and Sensmeier emailed their absence for tonight's meeting.

ORAL COMMUNICATIONS

Commissioner Diaz noted he was a recreation leader for City of Fontana and that is great that Director Martin is giving part time staff opportunities within the department.

Chair Franklin wanted to follow up on the lights at Walnut Grove for adding field lighting and asked if there has been an impact report or field use availability if the fields were lit. Director Martin noted there has not been an environmental impact study for lighting but we did go down this road for Las Posas and the lighting technology is so good that the lighting splash is very controlled. City staff will have to look into this and see if this is a priority and what funds are available to see what options we have.

Chair Franklin asked if there is an update on the language access plan that Commission Robles commented on at the last meeting. Assistance Director Gonzalez noted this will be a long process as we are still onboarding a contractor and as it evolves we will update the Commission.

Commissioner was not able to attend the fireworks but she did hear how phenomenal the fireworks show was in San Marcos.



Chair Franklin thanked everyone who participated in the 4th of July event and he will be attending the General Plan meeting tomorrow.


