Regular Meeting of the Parks and Recreation Commission

CALL TO ORDER

At 6:02p.m. Parks and Recreation Commission Chair Franklin called the meeting to order.

Director Martin told the Commission that Assistant Director Andrea Gonzalez will be taking on the role of overseeing the Commission and will be running the meetings going forward.

CONSENT CALENDAR

1&2. Approval of Minutes, 08/17/2022 and Approval of General Facility Scheduling, 10/20 - 11/16/2022

MOVED BY COMMISSIONER SENSMEIER, SECOND BY COMMISSIONER PRESTININZI AND CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY TO APPROVE CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS #1 & #2 AS PRESENTED.

REPORTS AND OTHER BUSINESS

3. Annual Staff Report

Jennifer Overman, Recreation Supervisor Senior Services, gave the presentation.

Jennifer told the Commission that the Senior Activity Center (SAC) is open Monday – Friday 8am-4pm. The SAC offers a variety of activities, classes, events, and more. Senior favorites include Zumba class, bingo, DIY craft day, and more.

The SAC serves lunch everyday Monday – Friday 11:30am sharp and on Tuesdays and Thursdays they also have a salad and soup bar and it is a success as they have 30-40 people just for the salad and soup bar. The volunteers prep all the fresh vegetables and make the soup from scratch and it has been a great addition to the catered hot meal.

The SAC also has Mix and Mingle events with live entertainment and monthly parties at lunch time. They recently hosted an Over 90's Party with almost 100 people in attendance. They hold craft fairs, parking lot sales, teas and more. The Billiards room was recently renovated and has three new Diamond Pool tables for the seniors to play on.

A survey was conducted a short survey in March of 2022 on survey monkey via email and in person at the Senior Center. Questions asked where "how often do you visit the center", "what programs do you participate in", "what would you like to see offered". The survey indicated that most people do come to the center more than once a week. Classes, activities and lunch are the most heavily participated in. Fitness classes was the highest ranking category they would like to see more of offered followed by music and special interest classes.

Commissioner Smith asked on average how many people come into the center daily. Jenifer said it is hard to measure as people come and go all different times throughout the day but around 200 people is her guestimate. Smith asked if people use the fitness zone area outside of the center. Jennifer said there is a person out there occasionally. Smith asked if there is any limitations on finding instructors to teach classes. Jennifer said it can be a bit hard to find instructors as they have to have the skill and the time to teach and also split class fees with the City.

Commissioner Sensmeier asked if the center has any classes related to health and mental health. Jennifer noted they partner with the County of San Diego and they offer workshops throughout the year. They also have Alzheimer's Association class on site regularly. Sensmeier said in general since Covid, mental health is a crisis and with the seniors being affected by being isolated for quite some time.

Commissioner Mockus-Valenzuela stated that the County has done a lot of intergenerational activities with youth, but perhaps they Senior Activity Center could do activities with the 50-60 range and the 70-80 range and engage that community and an opportunity to make friendships and combat isolation. Jennifer said if she could just get the middle aged group to get past the stigma of the senior center, they would really enjoy what the center has to offer.

Commissioner Robles said that the center offers amazing activities and asked what outreach efforts are being done to make sure the center is including everyone who may want the services offered at the center. Jennifer noted they promote the center everywhere they go, they collaborate with other organizations and committees, and at all the City events the Senior Center is promoted; She added they just had parking lot sale and the community and neighborhood stops by and staff are promoting the center telling everyone what the center offers. Robles noted there is no formal outreach plan that it is more word of mouth. Jennifer noted they promote the center as we do all of our other City offerings with the 360 Recreation Guide, emails, social media and the Senior Newsletter publication that is emailed and printed monthly. Robles asked if the ethnicity was surveyed and Jennifer noted it was not as they wanted to keep the survey short, but there is all ethnicities who attend the center.

Chair Franklin asked what data the “other” category option captured. Jennifer noted those comments were used by the Senior Center and it included comments about what classes they like and other stuff that was already captured in the survey. Franklin asked how are numbers are prior to pre-Covid. Jennifer would say we have recovered and the lunch numbers alone are higher and the center is very busy and vibrant. Franklin asked if there is anything that has evolved or grown out of the Covid experience. Jennifer said they have a tech internship through Cal State University with volunteer student's onsite daily from 9am-3:30pm to assist seniors with their technical needs. Franklin asked how the iPad initiative went. Jennifer noted the program went well and the year ended and we collected the tablets back. We are looking for a volunteer to lead a program utilizing the tablets but we did notice the seniors want help with their own device so having the tech student's onsite has been working out nicely.

Chair Franklin thanked Jennifer for answering all of the questions and noted they appreciate the work that she does.

4. Commercial Use Request- San Diego Waves

Commissioners reviewed the application.

5. Park Naming Policy Update

Assistant Director Gonzalez said there is not an update and the policy is still in the City Managers Office and she will provide information as it comes.

6. Q1 Statistics Report

Commissioners reviewed the statistics and asked questions which staff answered.

7. Youth Sports Council Meeting Minutes- September 6, 2022

Commissioner Sensmeier attended the meeting. It was a great meeting and James and the Committee got a lot accomplished. Everything is going well and they are working together and communicating.

8. Trails Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes- October 12, 2022

Chair Franklin attended the meeting and it was great to see new TAC members. The committee has homework to revamp the trail etiquette flyer for equestrian, hikers and bikers using our trails.

Assistant Director Gonzalez noted the etiquette for yielding will be changed on this flyer to have equestrian icon on the top and once that is updated we will recreate the signage at the parks and trails in the equestrian areas.

9. Trails Advisory Committee Application

MOVED BY COMMISSIONER ROBLES, SECOND BY COMMISSIONER SENSMEIER AND CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY TO APPOINT TORREY OLSON TO THE TRAILS ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

PARKS AND RECREATION DIRECTOR REPORT

Assistant Director Andrea Gonzalez informed the Commission on department events and updates in the department including the Breakfast with the Littlest Pumpkin, Halloween Party at the Wood House, San Marcos Hike, Veterans Day Event at Helen Bouger Park, and a Photography show at the Community Center. Andrea invited Commissioners to the CPRS District 12 workshop on November 16th in Coronado. Andrea thanked Commissioner Sensmeier for volunteering at the Chamber of Commerce Street Fair.

Andrea reported that Kat Trost the Aquatics Supervisor has given her notice as she is making some big life changes and moving out of state so her position will be recruited for.

Public Works plans to renovate Simmons Family Park playground and Andrea showed Commissioners preliminary illustrations of the new playground design. The playground will feature slides, net climbing walls with an eagle's nest at the top of the structure, a zip line, round swing and some spinners.

Construction will start soon at Las Posas Pool to better house the chemicals onsite.

The Nature Center has been renovated and is close to be done as Erin Rimmereid has been working hard to complete it for the school groups and the community. We plan to have a grand reopening in January with a ribbon cutting to spread the word about this hidden gem in the Community.

The City Planning Department is working with a consultant on an active transportation plan and conducting surveys and audits and site visits to get information on safe routes to school, traffic flow and biking and walking flow in San Marcos.

Commissioner Prestinini and Robles terms are expiring and so they can reapply on the City website.

Commissioner Sensmeier noted she is happy to see the zip line in the park and it will be a real plus for our park system. She is also happy to see the transportation plan happening as the Double Peak area has so much congestion.

Call to order

Eric Leichliter called the Youth Sports Council meeting to order at 6:00pm.

Approval of Minutes

Torry Schoch (Lacrosse) motioned to approve the minutes from the September 6, 2022 meeting. Katie Anderson (AYSO 1505) seconded the motion.

San Marcos Unified School District Update

Not Present- no update provided to City staff to present.

Eric reminded YSC members that access to SMUSD fields requires permits through Facilitron.

Sport Field Updates

The sports fields update was given by Stew Rutledge.

Stew informed all members that:

-MSP field 3 windscreens were damaged and replacements have been ordered and will be installed when received.

-Connors netting replacement project will begin on November 14 and should take a few days. Musco lighting will also re-lamp the lights on the field under warranty since there were outages. Stew reminded all YSC members that the turf replacement project will begin on Monday, November 28 and the field will be closed through the end of the year.



-Stew asked all YSC soccer organizations to please remind coaches to rotate where they hold their drills at the parks to prevent any excessive wear in one spot. He also asked all organizations to move field locations for their games every couple of weeks at locations where it is possible.

-Stew notified the YSC members that the City has to cut back watering to twice per week with new drought restrictions.

-Stew and Eric reminded all members of the upcoming field closure periods. All lighted multipurpose fields will be closed from January 1-February 28, 2023 and June 1-July 31, 2023 to allow for rest and renovations before the busy fall season.

-Katie Anderson (AYSO 1505) provided an update on AYSO 1505's board. Katie stated that they have a new board in place; however, she will remain as the contact person while the board gets acclimated to their new roles.
