A request for reasonable accommodation may include a modification or exception to the rules, standards, policies, and practices for the siting, development, and use of housing or housing-related facilities that would eliminate or modify regulatory barriers to provide a person with a disability equal opportunity to housing of their choice as per [Chapter 20.440](#) of the City of San Marcos Municipal Code.
