The meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM

Roll Call

Chair Norris, Group Members Freeman, Kerschbaum, and Rungaitis all present. Staff: Sean Harris, Management Analyst and Tess Sangster, Community and Economic Development Director also present. Staff noted the resignation of Group Member Potl in June

New Business

1. Approval of Minutes from June 16, 2021 meeting;

Group Member Kerschbaum motioned to approve the minutes, Group Member Freeman seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

2. Informational Item: Benefits – Risks – Costs Matrix for Community Choice Aggregation Options available to City (Related Measure of Climate Action Plan: E-3).

Staff provided information on the potential benefits, risks and costs associated with the four Community Choice Aggregation options available to the City. Working Group members discussed the item and staff answered questions about the options. Chair Norris suggested that staff consider negotiating a term or trial membership in one of the two area CCAs. Members of the working group expressed intent to speak at upcoming City Council Workshop on CCA options.

3. Informational Item: Council Approved SB 1383 Ordinance and Franchise Agreement (Related Measure of Climate Action Plan: S-1).

Staff provided information on the Ordinance that was introduced and approved at the October 12, 2021 City Council meeting to bring the City's Municipal Code and programs into compliance with state law related to organic waste recovery. A general discussion of the waste diversion elements of the Climate Action Plan ensued, and Working Group Member Rungaitis suggested that staff coordinate times for members of the working group to tour the Anaerobic Digester facility at EDCO's Escondido location.

Working Group Member Comments

Chair Norris suggested that the City research the EV charging station company Electrify America to see if their services might fit into the Climate Action Plan's goals. Working Group Member Kerschbaum suggested that staff research the San Diego Building Electrification Coalition to see if their initiatives and programs might fit into the City's Climate Action Plan's commitments, staff requested contact information for both groups.
