


# POTTED FLOWER PENS

## Materials:

Flowers, floral tape, pens, rocks and a plant pot.

## Instructions:

1. Remove the cap from the pen (you will not need this anymore)
2. Choose a flower and hold it at the top of the pen with the stem pointed down
3. Use floral tape to completely wrap the stem of the flower and pen (leave tip of pen out so you can write)
4. Decorate your flower pot
5. Add rocks to your pot and place your pens inside


# DRIFTWOOD WIND CHIMES

## Materials:

Create your very own wind chime using driftwood, string, beads and bells.

## Instructions:

1. Decorate the driftwood stick
2. Add beads onto string and tie around driftwood
3. Secure bottom bead with knot or bell
4. Use remaining string to create a hanger
5. Hang outside and enjoy your new creation!

# ROCK PHOTO HOLDER

## Materials:

Turn an ordinary rock into a unique photo holder.  
Kits include rocks, paint, wire and beads.

## Instructions:

1. Decorate your rocks with paint
2. Allow rocks to dry
3. Take wire and twist around a pencil about 5-8 times to create a spiral shape
4. Straighten the remainder of the wire and add beads
5. Bend the bottom part of the wire around the rock so the spiral is in the air
6. Add and photo
7. Display proudly!



# MASON JAR CAMP LANTERN

## Materials:

Create a camp lantern with a glass mason jar, tissue paper, mod podge, pipe cleaners and a battery operated tea light.

## Instructions:

1. Cut/rip tissue paper into small strips and shapes
2. Paint glue onto the mason jar and add tissue paper
3. Once your jar is covered with paper, add more glue on top and let dry completely
4. Wrap a pipe cleaner around the neck of the jar tightly
5. Wrap another pipe cleaner up and over the jar to make a handle
6. Leave one side unattached
7. Place beads on the pipe cleaner and secure

Place your light inside and enjoy your very own camp lantern!



# GLOWING BOTTLE FIREFLY

## Materials:



Create a glowing firefly friend with a bottle, pipe cleaners, google eyes, tulle fabric and glowing lights.

## Instructions:

1. Drink the water inside the water bottle and remove the outside label
2. Glue colored tissue paper or tulle fabric on the outside of the bottle
3. Once dry, wrap pipe cleaners around the center of the bottle to form the legs
4. Cut wings from the foam sheet and place on back
5. Put glowing light inside the bottle
6. Glue google eyes on the bottle cap and add a pipe cleaner to form antenna



# FALL LEAF WREATH

## Materials:

Create your very own leaf wreath using glue, a cardboard wreath, ribbon, and faux fall leaves.


## Instructions:

1. Take a leaf and brush glue on one side
2. Place the glue side of the leaf on the cardboard wreath frame until it sticks
3. Continue this process until the entire wreath is covered with fall leaves
4. Once dry, take the ribbon and tie it around the top of your wreath, creating a loop
5. Display proudly

**FUN TIP:** As the seasons change, add new leaves and holiday decor so you can display your wreath year round!



# MONSTER VISORS



## Materials:

Turn a foam visor into a monster cap! Use google eyes, pipe cleaners, foam stickers, and faux fur to create a Halloween monster masterpiece!

## Instructions:

1. Remove all items from the bag
2. Pick and choose from the materials provided to create your very own monster visor
3. With parent permission, add other items (such as cupcake liners and paper triangles for teeth) to make your visor extra spooky

## Challenge

Find clothes and accessories that you already have to complete your monster look and make your own spooky costume!



# PUMPKIN PIE TIME



## Materials:

Make a delicious pumpkin pie at home! Ingredients include a 9-inch pie crust, 16 oz of pumpkin puree, 14 oz of sweetened condensed milk, two whole eggs, and 1 teaspoon of pumpkin pie spice


## Instructions:

1. Preheat oven to 425 degrees Fahrenheit
2. Beat eggs in a medium-sized bowl. Mix in pumpkin puree, condensed milk, and pumpkin pie spice
3. Mix ingredients until smooth
4. Pour the mixture into the prepared pie crust
5. Bake at 425 degrees for 15 minutes
6. Wrap foil around the edge of the pie crust to prevent the crust from burning. Reduce heat to 350 degrees and continue baking until the pie is firm in the center when shaken lightly (approx 45 min)
7. Cool to at least room temperature before serving



### Quick tips

Insert a knife into the pie, about an inch away from the crust. If it comes out clean, the filling is set and it's ready to remove from the oven.  
Cover the pie with storage wrap and store in the fridge for up to four days.



# NO-BAKE CINNAMON ORNAMENTS



## Materials:

Mix ground cinnamon, applesauce and glue to make no-bake ornaments! Make them to hang at home or give as a gift. Decorate with white puffy paint to look like icing!

## Instructions:

1. Mix 1 cup ground cinnamon, 1 cup applesauce and 2 tbsp glue in a large bowl until well blended. The mixture will become stiff. Use a little more applesauce if your mix isn't pliable (it should be like a pie or pizza dough)
2. Form the dough into a ball and place it on a sheet of wax or parchment paper. Roll the dough to about 1/4 inch thick (3.5 cm)
3. Using cookie cutters, cut dough out in desired shapes
4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 with leftover dough until you have used up as much dough as you can.
5. For ornaments, use the straw to poke a hole at the top of your ornaments to thread the ribbon for hanging, keeping about 1/4 inch away from the top edge.
6. Place ornaments on a flat surface to air dry; a cookie cooling rack works best. Let them dry for 48-72 hours, turning them over halfway through the drying period.
7. If you want to dry your ornaments faster, place them in an oven at 200 degrees for about 2.5 hours.
8. Once they are dry, thread the ribbon through the hole and tie in a knot.
9. Decorate with puffy paint to look like icing



# NO-BAKE CINNAMON ORNAMENTS



## *Tips:*

- If the spice dough is too wet, it will stick to the wax paper, so start with the recommended amount of applesauce only adding if it is dry.
- The glue helps these ornaments stay strong, so do not substitute it for water or another liquid.
- Use plastic wrap to cover the dough while working on the their cutouts.



# NO-SEW FLEECE SCARF

## Materials:

- One long piece of white fabric
- Small strips of colored fabric

## Instructions:

1. Take the long strip of white fabric, this is going to be the body of the scarf
2. Tie small strips of colorful fabric to white piece in any order or pattern
3. Keep adding strips of fabric until no white is showing and the scarf is warm and fluffy
4. Wear proudly!



# FLUFFY VALENTINE SLIME

## Materials:

- 1/2 teaspoon Baking soda
- 1/4 cup Water
- 1 teaspoon Acrylic paint
- 3 cups Shaving cream
- 2 Tablespoons contact lens solution
- 6 ounces Elmer's white school glue (3/4 CUP)



## Instructions:

1. Add white glue, baking soda, and water into a large mixing bowl
2. Mix well
3. Add a few small squeezes of acrylic paint – about 1 teaspoon worth.  
The more you add the darker your slime will be.
4. Add the shaving cream
5. Stir well until everything is combined. The mixture should be smooth, puffy and the colour should be consistent.
6. Pour 2 Tablespoons of contact solution into to the glue mixture, and stir. As you stir, it will start firming up and getting stringy. Keep stirring until it has a good slime consistency and it stops sticking to the side of the bowl. If the slime is still sticking to your hands, add a little bit more contact lens solution into the mixture.

## Quick tips



For a marbled look, make another batch of slime in a different color. Once complete, mix the two together to get multicolored fluffy slime
