MINUTES

Regular Meeting of the Parks and Recreation Commission

CALL TO ORDER

At 6:00 p.m. Parks and Recreation Commission Chair Franklin called the meeting to order.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Chair Franklin led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Also present were: Parks and Recreation Director Mark Olson, Assistant Director Andrea Gonzalez, Development Services Director Isaac Etchamendy and Management Analyst Evelyn Slay.

ORAL COMMUNICATIONS

The Commission recognized Home Depot volunteers, Julie Paulus, Dez Thorpe, and Jeffrey Page for their contributions to the summer youth adventure day camps. They hosted two free workshops for over 200 campers.

CONSENT CALENDAR

1. Approval of Minutes, 1/17/2024

MOVED BY COMMISSIONER SENSMEIER, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER MOCKUS-VALENZUELA AND CARRIED TO APPROVE UNANIMOUSLY CONSENT CALENDAR ITEM #1 AS PRESENTED.

2. Approval of General Facility Scheduling, 2/22 - 3/20/2024

MOVED BY COMMISSIONER SENSMEIER, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER MOCKUS-VALENZUELA AND CARRIED TO UNANIMOUSLY APPROVE CONSENT CALENDAR ITEM #2 AS PRESENTED.

3. Annual Report – NFL Flag Football

4. Staff Report- Isaac Etchamendy

Development Services Director Isaac Etchamendy gave the presentation. He provided a summary of the financial health of the City and budget deficit, the proposed long term financial plan options, and the exploration of a sales tax initiative at Council's direction.

Commissioner Sensmeier asked about the 7 cents of the property tax the city receives and the option to change it. Isaac advised it would require the State Legislature to change Prop 13.

Commissioner Sensmeier inquired about staff contacting other local cities that may be experiencing similar challenges with the property tax limitations. Isaac advised a change in the legislature would be an unlikely path, but local cities have identified creative financial approaches to the property tax issue, including our city, whose previous manager incorporated the use of community facility districts to make up some of the differential, but it only goes so far. Isaac noted that at the Council's direction to solve the budget issue, City Manager and staff have been asked to look at all available options.

Commissioner Sensmeier asked about the use of commercial space and new developments. He advised that commercial use space and property portfolio are doing well but are at the point where it is not enough.

Commissioner Prestinanzi inquired about what CalPERS is; Isaac explained it's one of the largest pension systems in government of which our full-time staff are part of, along with some other local agencies and state employees. He explained the system and reviewed how the city was responsible for the difference in its employees' portion of the fund, when the return on investment did not hit the mark.

Commissioner Diaz asked about in-house services versus outsourcing. Isaac provided background on what was done many years ago when departments analyzed the value to the city between in-house services and outsourcing. At the time, it was determined outsourcing was best, but a recent analysis has found that in some departments it is more cost-effective to bring positions in-house.

Commissioner Smith asked about developer contributions towards community needs. Isaac advised that developers pay one-time fees, some of which are restricted and cannot be used toward operational expenses. He informed the Commission that Donna the Finance Director was conducting a review of all administrative fees, while he was overseeing the review of PFF fees.

Commissioner Smith asked how our fees compared to other cities, to which Isaac confirmed we are lower, and the goal is to be in line with other cities for better cost recovery, while not deterring developers from doing business in the city.

Chair Franklin asked if a sales tax initiative has been considered before or if it was something new. Issac mentioned this is the first time in at least 13-yrs the period he has been with the city and did not have information on any tax measures that might have sunset, but in recent history it is new.

5. Q2 Program Statistics.

Commissioner Diaz asked what month the Q2 covers. Staff advised Q2 is October, November, December, based on the start of the Fiscal Year.

Commissioner Mockus-Valenzuela asked about comparative data from previous years to include pre-pandemic numbers. Staff noted some limitations with the historical data and what was captured. Commissioner Mockus-Valenzuela asked if we could include moving forward the Quarter statistics and the

cumulative year-to-date graphs for each division. Staff advised this change would be made to future program statistic reports.

Commissioner Smith asked about aquatics class numbers. Assistant Director Gonzalez explained the numbers reflected the decrease in Q2 of 2022 were due to the loss of the aqua aerobics instructor during the pandemic. The increase in Q2 of 2023, reflected the start of the program under staff direction, rather than a contract instructor.

Chair Franklin asked about the footnote for number 4 in the Facility Reservations report. He noted the 45% decrease did not match the last two applications and locations for Stroller Strides. He advised it would be helpful to see the historical data to compare what the true change was for the commercial use and the community they were servicing. Staff advised the report footnote advised of a change from the previous quarter to Open Area, which is a filter in ActiveNet Insights, depending on the actual usage of the park locations, the report could reflect an increase, decrease, or no change in usage. Staff also advised the group mentioned in the report had most recently cancelled several of their meetings, showing a similar trend.

Commissioner Mockus-Valenzuela asked about reaching out to other commercial use applications to increase revenues. She stated she understands that an increase in utilization also increases maintenance and repair costs to the fields but asked if staff proactively sought new applicants. Assistant Director Gonzalez provided history on the commercial use application and why it was implemented and confirmed the cost to maintain the fields is far greater than the revenue the commercial use would generate.

Commissioner Smith asked about the decrease in RAA Preschoolers and if state programs have contributed to the decrease. Assistant Director Gonzalez confirmed that staff has noticed that residents are opting for the free state programs, rather than the city enrichment programming. Staff will analyze the best use of staff and resources for future programming.

Chair Franklin asked about the color contrast to make sure numbers show better on the graphs. Staff will make the change to make sure the information is visible.

6. Park Naming Policy Update

Assistant Director Gonzalez noted the policy is still under review with the City Attorney's Office. Most recently their office asked for additional data to review.

7. Youth Sports Council Meeting Minutes

Commissioners had an opportunity to review the minutes. Vice-Chair Lindsay attended the meeting. Commissioner Diaz will attend the May 7th meeting.

ORAL COMMUNICATIONS

Director Mark Olson introduced himself to the Commission. He provided a summary of his experience over the last 25 years in parks and recreation and his goals now that he is here in San Marcos.

Commissioner Sensmeier asked about Director Olson's experience with youth sports councils in his previous agencies. Director Olson shared his background includes agencies with both adult and youth sports councils such as Poway and agencies that did not have any sports councils. He noted he has observed from afar the COSM YSC and has found that what we have in place works for our community needs and looks forward to continuing the working relationship with the groups.

Commissioner Mockus-Valenzuela asked about department priorities in addition to the budget deficit. Director Olson shared budget was high on the list and part of that was finding creative ways to make the best out of the resources we have and make every dollar stretch as much as we can.

Commissioner Mockus-Valenzuela asked if he saw an opportunity to engage older youth groups, typically of high school age who may have outgrown current programming and are not participating in recreational activities. Director Olson noted he was aware of the age gap for those 14 years of age and older who may not join a competitive sports group and age out of the existing recreational programming. His goal was to work collaboratively with groups such as the SMUSD who may have access to ELAP funds to create opportunities for that age group. The challenge he noted was not just access but getting those students to enroll. He does believe it can be done by working together with various community partners and focusing on outreach.

Chair Franklin asked about the plans for replacing Recreational Supervisor II James Daza once he retires later this year. Director Olson advised the team would be working together to identify the best approach to recruit and replace James. While maintaining the same level of service to the member agencies and setting up that person for the best possible road. Over the next couple of months, the team would be working on this to make sure there is a seamless transition and no loss in service to the groups. Chair Franklin advised that overcommunication to the YSC groups of the process would be most advantageous for everyone.

Commissioner Robles shared with Director Olson the need to identify ways to reach community groups who may not use social media or get the information through a flyer, who are also in need of access to affordable programs. He thanked Commissioner Robles for the question and noted he hopes to find the best way possible to reach those individuals who do not have the connection and find the best way to service them.

Speaker Slip for Oral Communication from the Historical Society about Walnut Grove Park:

Tanice Brown from the group thanked staff for their care of the fields and communication. She also thanked staff and the city for allowing the reutilization of the old caretaker unit that is now at Heritage Park. She asked what was going to happen to the old Jensen House that was recently being moved. Development Services Director Etchamendy advised the house was classified as uninhabitable and will be demolished. Tanice asked if it was possible to collect the plaque that was at the house to add to the collection of historical items. Director Etchamendy agreed to assist in the collection and delivery of the plaque.

PARKS AND RECREATION ASSISTANT DIRECTOR REPORT

The Assistant Director Gonzalez shared a summary of the department events including staffing updates.

Staff are currently working on the summer recreation guide and camp preview which was highly popular last year.

Aquatics Supervisor Recruitment is underway, and the first round of interviews will happen in the next couple of days.

Bradley Park construction is moving forward with a few delays due to the rain.

Highlight of monthly programs: Pop-Up Rec & Family Night Craft Pick-Up.

The Creek Ribbon Cutting Event will happen on April 5th at 10am, the commissioners will receive more information as details are confirmed.

San Marcos Spring Street Fair Festival is on April 7th.

Commissioner Sensmeier asked about the recent rain and any issues at the parks. Assistant Director Gonzalez advised there were no issues from the parks and recreation side. She confirmed staff have followed the regular rainy day communication process which includes any field closures or permits and have shared the refund process with those that it applies to.

Commissioner Smith asked about the pick-up times for the craft kit sales. Assistant Director Gonzalez advised the kits could be picked up at any time during the front desk operational hours. She also asked about the birthday party program at Jack's Pond Nature Center. Assistant Director Gonzalez shared the team would be having a pilot program in March and a soft opening before making the program available to the public.

Chair Franklin asked to have the Creek Ribbon Cutting event added to the commissioner's calendars. Chair Franklin also mentioned the need for better visuals aides for the Spring Fair. Assistant Director Gonzalez confirmed the coyote would not be used until it was fixed, and staff would plan to have better visuals for the fair. The sign-up sheet for the fair will be shared next month.

Commissioner Robles asked when the customer service survey would close and when the results would be published. She advised she took survey in Spanish, and it was great. Staff did not have the specific details but will investigate the survey deadline.

Chair Franklin shared with the Commission that he would not be able to attend the March 13th Trails Advisory Sub-Committee Meeting and opened the opportunity to the other commissioners who may be interested in attending.
