CATCH-A-RIDE SENIOR TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM FAQs

WHAT IS CATCH-A-RIDE?

CATCH A RIDE! Is the City of San Marcos transportation program that provides two transportation options for seniors – Lunch Shuttle and Ride Service.

WHAT IS THE LUNCH SHUTTLE?

The Lunch Shuttle transports seniors to and from the Senior Center for the lunch program Monday-Friday (except for holidays and other posted closures). \$1 suggested contribution each way. \$5 suggested contribution for lunch.

WHAT IS RIDE SERVICE?

Ride Service offers transport seven (7) days a week for general purpose trips to any location within San Marcos City limits. \$2.50 each way.

IS THERE A RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT?

Yes. Participants must live in the City of San Marcos. San Marcos residents have a zip code of 92069 or 92078. Those residing in other zip codes or in Lake San Marcos are non-residents. Proof of residency can be verified by providing a document or record with your current address. Examples: copy of driver's license, utility bill or lease.

IS THERE AN AGE REQUIREMENT?

Yes. Residents 60+ years of age are eligible to participate in the program. Proof of age is required by providing a document or record stating your date of birth. Examples: copy of driver's license, ID card or birth certificate.

IS THERE AN INCOME REQUIREMENT?

Yes. Income eligibility is based on current Housing and Urban Development (HUD) guidelines for the City of San Marcos. \$3796/monthly. Proof of income is required by providing a copy of your most recent tax return.

DO I HAVE TO REGISTER FOR THE PROGRAM?

Yes. Program eligibility and registration is required. **For more information or to schedule an appointment, please call the Senior Center at (760) 744-5535, ext. 3605.**
