This notice is to inform you of an upcoming joint public workshop being held by San Marcos Unified School District (SMUSD) in conjunction with the City of San Marcos (City) for the proposed San Marcos K-8 School project within San Elijo Hills. The project site is located along San Elijo Rd between Ledge Street and the Ridgeline Trail Staging Area. The workshop is intended to provide the public an overview of the proposed school design and the application for a General Plan Amendment, Rezone, and Specific Plan Amendment submitted to the City. As project area property owners, it is important to have your input on this project outlined below.

SMUSD has submitted an application to the City requesting approval of a General Plan Amendment, Rezone and Specific Plan for the school site. The proposed changes are intended to add 28.59 acres to 7.59 acres within the San Elijo Hills Specific Plan Area (SPA) for which SMUSD is proposing to develop a 36.18 acres K-8 School Site within the San Elijo Hills SPA for up to 1,500 students. The project area is shown on the map provided on the back side of this notice.

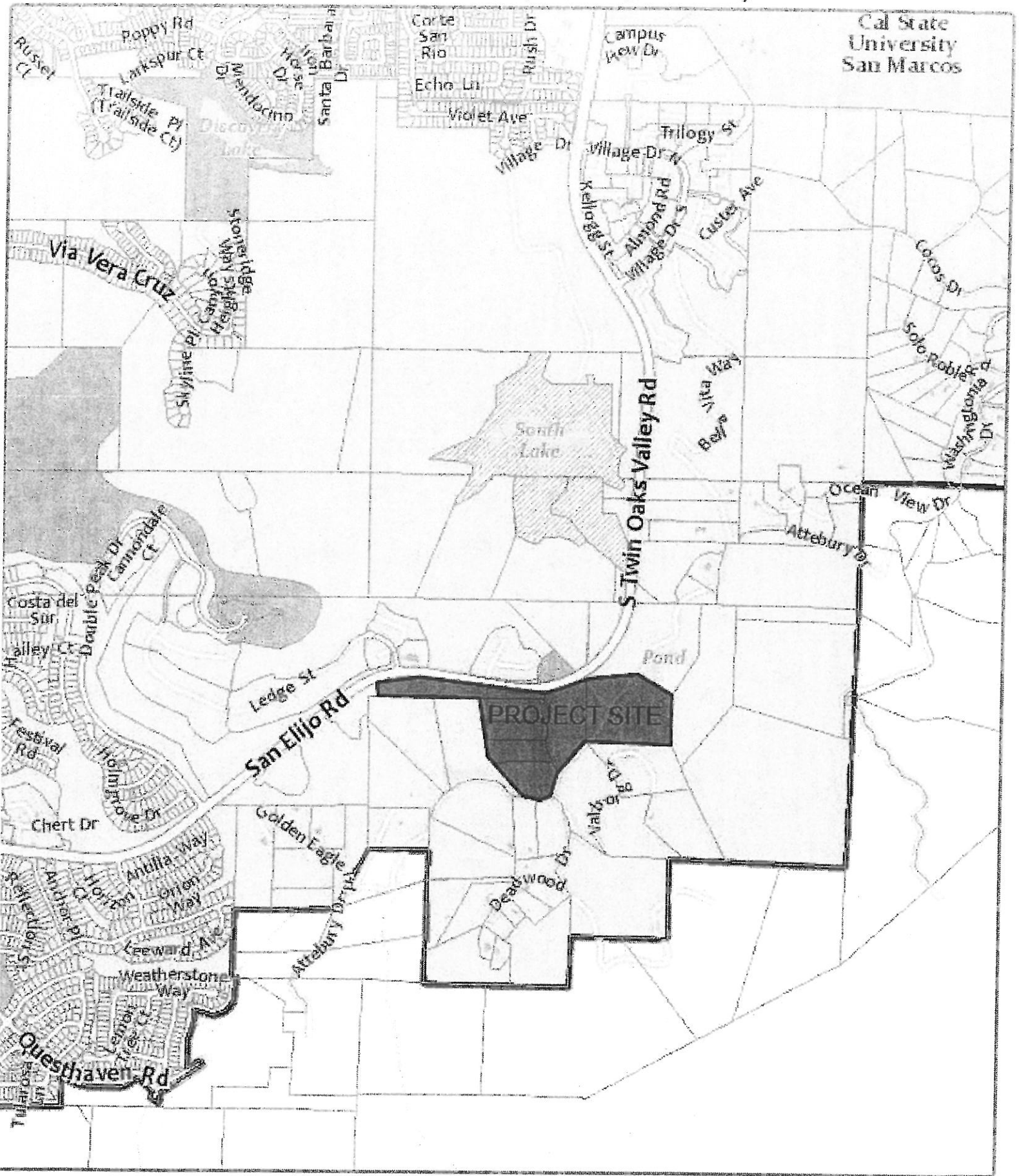
